# 13 DAY PILBARA & WA CORAL COAST TOUR

Visit stunning ancient gorges, endless stretches of white sandy beaches and untouched coral reefs.

DAY 1: (D) TO PORT HEDLAND

MONDAY 29 JULY 2024

Welcome to our Western Australia's Pilbara and Coral Coast tour. Today, we fly to Port Hedland where we are met and greeted before transferring to our hotel. **Port Hedland** main industries are iron ore processing and export, salt production from extensive evaporation ponds for export, shipping of manganese and other minerals, and livestock production – mainly cattle. The Port is one of the world's largest in tonnage terms, with over 70 million tonnes of product worth more than \$3 billion shipped each year.

**DAY 2: (BD) EXPLORING PORT HEDLAND****TUESDAY 30 JULY 2024**

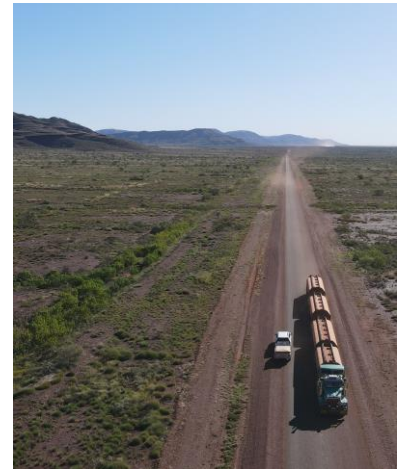
After breakfast we go to the **Port Hedland Seafarers Centre** where we will have a brief presentation before a lap around the harbour in one of the working, Seafarers Launch Service boats. It will be an exciting and unique experience. After lunch (own expense) Next, we explore Port Hedland with the help of a **local guide**. Tracing the cultural heritage and history of this most unusual town, our tour will follow the footsteps of the first European settlers by visiting the town's heritage sites. We will get the opportunity to learn about the human face to a town far more diverse than it may first appear. Afterwards, we return to our hotel for some time to relax by the pool.

**DAY 3: (BL) PORT HEDLAND TO NEWMAN****WEDNESDAY 31 JULY 2024**

An early start as we travel south on the Great Northern Highway to **Newman**. Taking in the stunning views as we travel through some of Australia's remote areas. We enjoy a **picnic lunch** taking in this remote world before arriving into **Newman**. On arrival we enjoy a tour of the 2<sup>nd</sup> largest single open-cut iron ore mine in the world. Discovered in 1957 by veteran prospector Stan Hilditch the iron ore deposit was named **Whaleback** due to its resemblance to the shape of the humpback whale. Take the opportunity for photos from the top of the pit and learn about the powerful machinery used in the mining of these rich ore deposits. (Clothing restrictions and shoe types apply. All guests must be fully vaccinated). Check in at the hotel for the night.

**DAY 4: (BD) NEWMAN TO TOM PRICE****THURSDAY 01 AUGUST 2024**

After breakfast, we spend explore the stunning **Karijini National Park**. Our first stop is at the incredible **Dales Gorge and Fortescue Falls. (1030)**. We enjoy lunch at **Karijini National Park Visitor Centre. (Own expense)** before visiting the impressive **Oxer Lookout**, and enjoy an uninterrupted view over the junction of four mighty gorges – Weano, Red, Hancock and Joffre. We finally arrive in **Tom Price** for our overnight accommodation before dinner inhouse.

**DAY 5: (B) TOM PRICE TO CORAL BAY****FRIDAY 02 AUGUST 2024**

An early departure this morning as our destination today is Coral Bay. Enjoy a stopover at Chaella Plains Station. (*Arranged by Specialty Travel*) We continue our journey taking in the wide-open spaces of the Australian outback before arriving at **Nanutarra Roadhouse** for our lunch break. (Own expense) We continue our travel day, arriving in to Coral Bay late afternoon. On arrival enjoy the smell of the ocean and fresh Seabreeze as we arrive at our accommodation. Dinner at own arrangements.

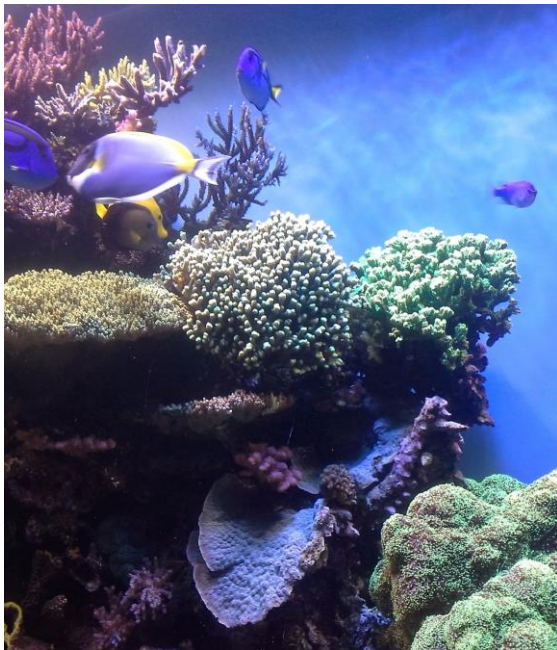


We explore the cape today travelling through a town that was established in 1964 to support the nearby United States Naval Communication Station Harold E Holt. The location however was first used as a military base in World War II and code-named *Potshot*. Nowadays the town relies more on tourism than the station for its existence. Exmouth is one of the few areas in Australia that can boast the "Range to Reef" experience. Today, we enjoy a unique and informative **cruise on Yardie Creek** with a park ranger, visit the *museum* at the Information Centre in Exmouth before taking in the views *Vlamingh Head Lighthouse*. Following along the coast travelling south, we stop at *Milyering Visitor Centre* before continuing into the **Cape Range National Park** which has some of the most spectacular gorges. The Cape Range National Park is a low and almost inaccessible spine of eroded limestone that runs up the peninsula towards North West Cape. We return back to our hotel to relax before enjoying one of the many local restaurants for dinner.

## DAY 7: (BD) CORAL BAY TO CARNARVON

SUNDAY 04 AUGUST 2024



This morning we embark on a special exploration of this beautiful reef. We make our way to the foreshore of Coral Bay where we board a **glass bottom boat** to cruise around the *Ningaloo Marine Park*. This boat will take us out to the Reef, which stretches 260 kilometres from Bundegi Reef near the town of Exmouth, to Amherst Point near Coral Bay in the south. These boats have huge glass panels to maximise our coral viewing experience. We enjoy open uninterrupted views from both above and below, as we cruise the pristine waters of the bay. (*Timing of this tour is dependent on the tides.*) After this very special cruise, we have lunch at Coral Bay (own expense) before departing further south. We stop to stretch our legs at *Minilya*, situated on the Minilya River, before the final part of today's journey which takes us past the full length of Lake McLeod. The lake occupies 2072 square kilometres and is only separated from the Indian Ocean by coastal dunes and rocky outcrops where both gypsite and salt are mined on the huge evaporation beds. Our final tour of the day is at the

*Carnarvon Space and Technology Museum*, the centre celebrates the little-known history of the role Carnarvon played in the space race. the station was built to support NASA's Gemini, Apollo and Skylab programs. We arrive at our hotel and check in for the night.

**DAY 8: (BLD) CARNARVON TO MONKEY MIA****MONDAY 05 AUGUST 2024**

Regional Australia is full of surprises and strange and awe-inspiring topographical wonders and today we will see one of its true mysteries. Our stop at **Hamelin Pool** to see a colony of Stromatolites (fossil micro-organisms) that date back to the beginning of life on earth. We enjoy a tour and lunch at the **Telegraph Station** before making our way **Eagle Bluff Lookout**. A 400-metre boardwalk, perched high above the shallow coastal waters offering stunning views providing the opportunity to spot wildlife like Ospreys, Dugongs, dolphins, sharks and rays. Arrive in **Monkey Mia**, our home for the next 2 nights.

**DAY 9: (BD) EXPLORING MONKEY MIA****TUESDAY 06 AUGUST 2024**

With any luck, today we'll experience Monkey Mia's well-known **wild dolphin encounter**. The friendly pop of bottlenose dolphins regularly swims to the shallows and interact with humans for a wonderful wildlife experience. Some time at leisure before enjoying our **sunset cruise**. Watch the stunning sight of the sky's continual change of colours reflected on the sea, as you cruise on the ocean, listening to the sounds of nature as the sun is setting over the Peron Peninsula.

**DAY 10: (BD) MONKEY MIA TO GERALDTON****WEDNESDAY 07 AUGUST 2024**

We have a travel day ahead as we make our way from Monkey Mia to **Geraldton**. Have your camera at the ready as we discover the spectacular **Kalbarri National Park**, featuring rugged sandstone cliffs, ancient rock formations and inland river gorges. We leisurely walk down the picturesque trail to **Natures Window**. The rock formation perfectly frames the rugged upstream view of the Murchison River giving incredible views. Next, we enjoy the breathtaking skywalk that delivers stunning vistas of the rust red cliffs, flowing water and bushland from high above.

**DAY 11: (BD) EXPLORING GERALDTON****THURSDAY 08 AUGUST 2024**

Proudly displaying its rich maritime and aboriginal heritage, Geraldton is a lively coastal town. Our touring starts at **HMAS Sydney II Memorial** where a local guide will talk about the loss of 645 crew members in 1941. Our next stop is at the **WA Museum**. Visit Shipwrecks Gallery and learn of the four Dutch shipwrecks - Batavia, Gilt Dragon, Zuytdorp, and Zeewijk. Witness the wrecks of HMAS Sydney (II) and HSK Kormoran as they currently lie, 2,500 metres deep on the ocean floor. The Museum's shop also has a great range of souvenirs, gifts and educational items suited to all ages and interests. We have an afternoon at leisure before dinner at **Skeetas Restaurant Bar & Cafe**.

This morning we make our way to **Cervantes** taking the newly opened scenic drive - Indian Ocean Road. We arrive in time for a lunch break (*own expense*) before our afternoon's visit to the **Nambung National Park** – home to the **Pinnacles**. This unique landscape of limestone pillars is like a moon scene, strange looking formations rising eerily out of the sand, some several metres tall. It is believed the Pinnacles were created millions of years ago as seashells were broken down into sand and then eroded by water and wind. We then head through Moora and on to the interesting town of **New Norcia**. It was here that the Spanish Benedictine monks established a monastery as an aboriginal mission and is now one of the great cultural heritage sites of Australia. Following a brief stop we continue into **Perth** for our last night including dinner.
